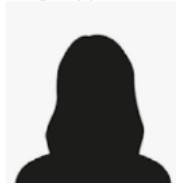

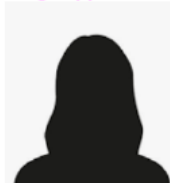

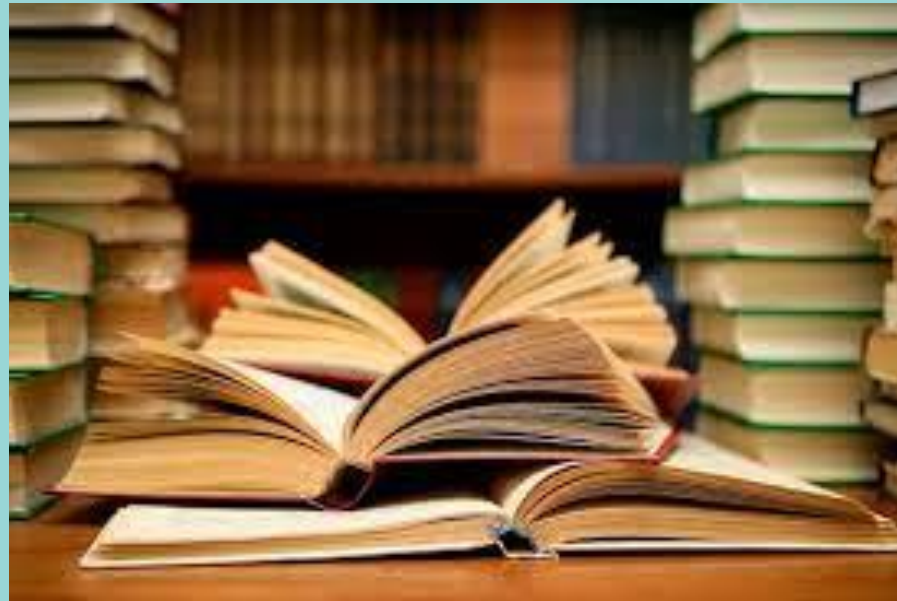

Uniform:
