Our school opened in September 2020 in a stunning new building, which we take pride in looking after and developing a beautiful learning environment for our children within. 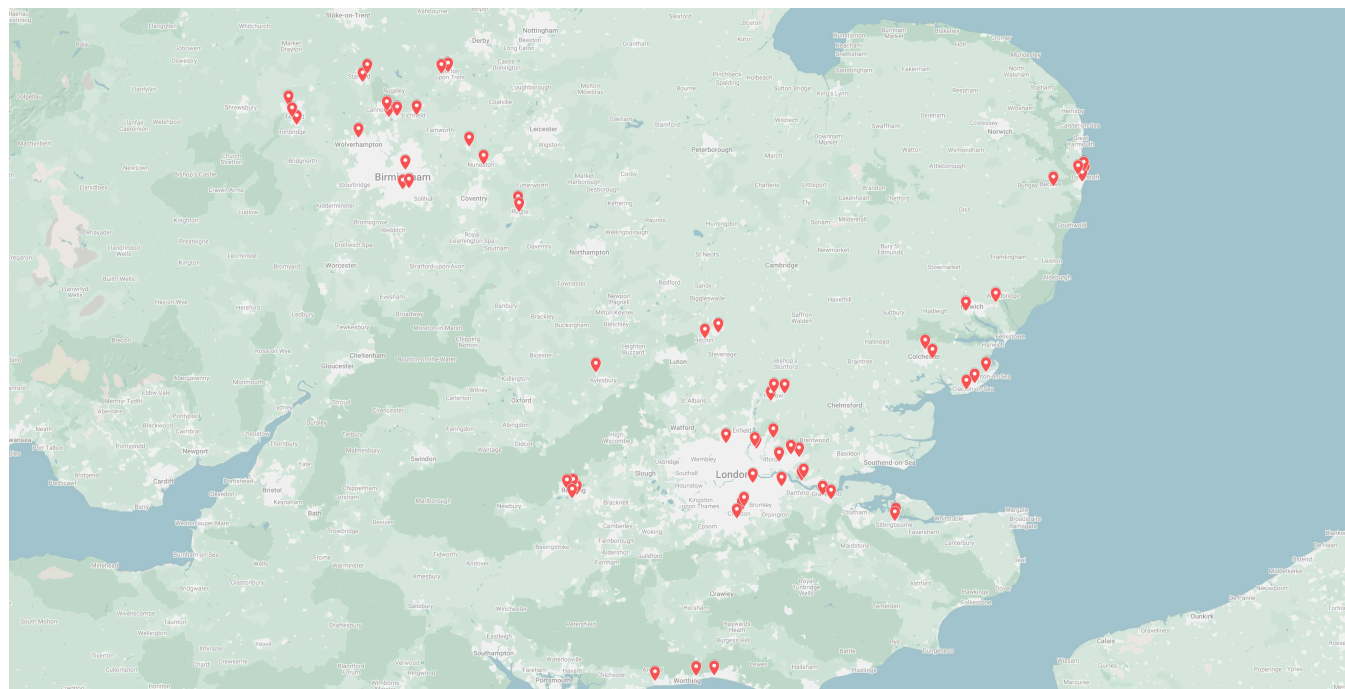
We're proud to be part of REAch2 Academy Trust—the largest primary-only trust in England, supporting over 60 schools across the country since 2012.

Our curriculum

Inspiring Learning, Shaping Futures

At Green Park Village Primary Academy, our curriculum does more than tick boxes—it sparks curiosity, builds confidence and prepares children for an ever-changing world.

From the nurturing foundations of Nursery and Reception to the ambitious learning of Year 6, every child follows a broad, balanced curriculum designed to excite and challenge. Rooted in the National Curriculum, our subjects are linked through big enquiry questions, helping children make meaningful connections and see the bigger picture.

We focus on the skills that matter for life—communication, emotional understanding, digital confidence and cultural awareness—all woven through everything we teach.

Reading is at the heart of it all. From phonics in Reception to rich novels in Year 6, our children develop a lifelong love of books and the tools to read with confidence.

In maths, we bring learning to life with hands-on resources and real-world problem-solving, building fluency through understanding—not just memorisation.

At Green Park Village Primary Academy, children don't just learn facts—they see themselves as future historians, scientists, authors and more.

At our school, learning goes far beyond the classroom. We want every child to discover just how much they're capable of—to grow in confidence, build lifelong skills and realise they can be extraordinary.

Through 11 Before 11, we promise every child 11 memorable adventures during their time with us—from Reception to Year 6. These moments push boundaries, build resilience and create joyful memories that last a lifetime.



Early Years

Early Learning provides the foundations for all learning. We work to ensure our children have the best start to their education.

We welcome our children into a beautiful and spacious inside and outside learning environment.

Our Early Years Teachers and Practitioners skilfully plan and set up a range of activities across all areas of learning to support our children in building on their skills and knowledge. The children learning through highly modelled inputs, in guided groups and through carefully structured and scaffolded purposeful play opportunities.

In addition to our Early Years children enjoying their own learning spaces, they are supported by our kind and caring older children when they join the whole school on our pitches for lunchtime play. This further helps them to develop their skills of social interaction.

Being a primary school, our curriculum builds on prior learning year on year and we are able to personalise learning opportunities and experiences to the individual needs of the children in our care.
